- In partnership with the Ekurhuleni municipality the agricultural project has an objective of building sustainable livelihoods for the people living closest to the project. The farm also serves as a training centre for emerging farmers and cooperatives.

To give meaningful and sustainable employment to the marginalised individuals within the neighboring communities

To develop co-operative businesses that will be owned and run by the same communities in the long-run

ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY (CONT....)



- A total of 100 seasonal jobs were created during the tomato production cycle and out of this 25 jobs were made permanent
- Currently the cabbage production cycle is running
- Economic benefit:
 - Jobs created
 - Food security
 - Produce supplied to the markets
 - Service providers role (transport, security, mobile toilets)
